Since 2008, The SPOT has served over 20,000 youth.



## The SPOT's free, confidential services include:


- Medical & reproductive health care

In 2023, The SPOT served 1,970 youth ages 13-24, including:



# 2023 services at a glance



### Sexual Health

- 6 HIV+ youth identified, all successfully linked to care
- 279 youth received a pregnancy test (6% positive)
- 289 youth received contraception
- 30 active PrEP clients supported

#### Behavioral Health

Youth screened positive for...

32% anxiety, 31% substance use, 28% trauma, 14% depression, 11% suicide

Top case management needs: emergency shelter and housing, rent or utility assistance, employment, food, child-care, clothing, medical care or insurance.
